And almost overnight, Ohio's state government is up and running with the new administration and members of the 133rd Ohio General Assembly.

The last three weeks have been a flurry of activity at the Ohio Statehouse, with newly elected and returning legislators being sworn into office (a photo directory, courtesy of Gongwer is available [here](#) for Ohio House members and [here](#) for Ohio Senate members), new members of the Ohio Supreme Court taking their seats, and the inauguration and oaths of offices for Ohio's new slate of statewide elected officials taking place. In addition, Ohio's 16 members of the US House (including newer faces from central Ohio - Troy Balderson and NE Ohio - Anthony Gonzales) and re-elected US Senator (and potential 2020 presidential candidate) Sherrod Brown will return to DC. After a long and contentious battle, State Representative Larry Householder was voted as to be the Speaker of the Ohio House. Householder held the position fifteen years ago before leaving the General Assembly due to term limits. The House Republican (majority) caucus has not yet finalized its leadership team. House Democrats recently announced their leadership team with Representative Fred Strahorn stepping down as minority leader after his failed effort to support Ryan Smith as speaker. A formal vote will take place in February, but Democratic leaders are expected to be Akron-area Emilia Sykes (minority leader), Columbus area Kristin Boggs as assistant minority leader, Euclid's Kent Smith and Toledo's Paula Hicks-Hudson round out the leadership team as minority whip and assistant minority whip).

Lake-area lawmaker Senator Randy Garnder has resigned his seat in order to accept a position in Governor DeWine's cabinet. State Representative Theresa Gavarone (Lucas Co) and Monclova Twp Trustee Barbara Lang have applied for the position. If Representative Gavarone is appointed, her seat will be open in the House for another appointment.

Governor DeWine continues to make cabinet appointments. In addition to the appointment of Mary Mertz as Director of ODNR, OLG members are likely interested to note that Dorothy Pelanda (attorney, farm owner, and former legislator) was named Director of the Department of Agriculture, Laurie Stevenson (long-time employee of the EPA) was named Director of the Environmental Protection Agency, and Jack Marchbanks was named Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation.
